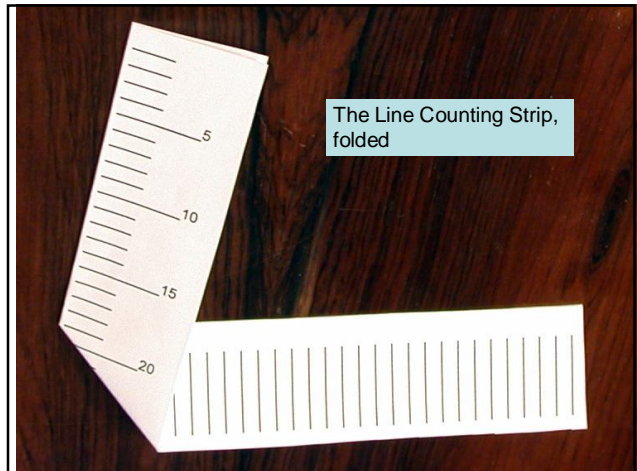
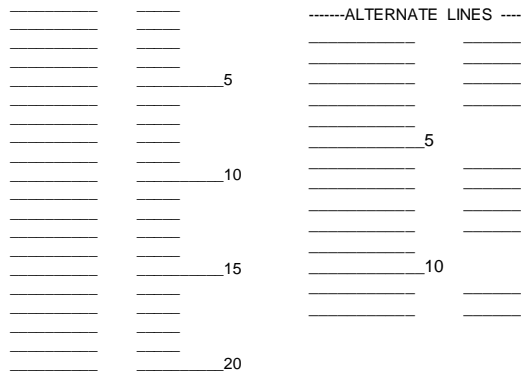

## MODIFIED WEINSTEIN LINE COUNTING PROCEDURE

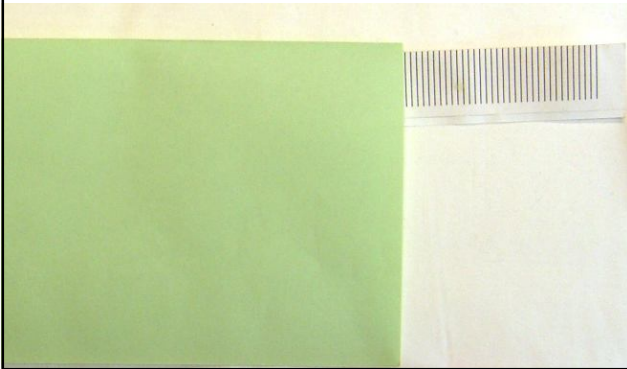
The current version:

- improves saccadic/fixation skills more effectively.
- does not require major amounts of professional help.
- uses the patient's own body movements to increase the use of peripheral vision.
- is self-administered
- integrates peripheral and central vision.

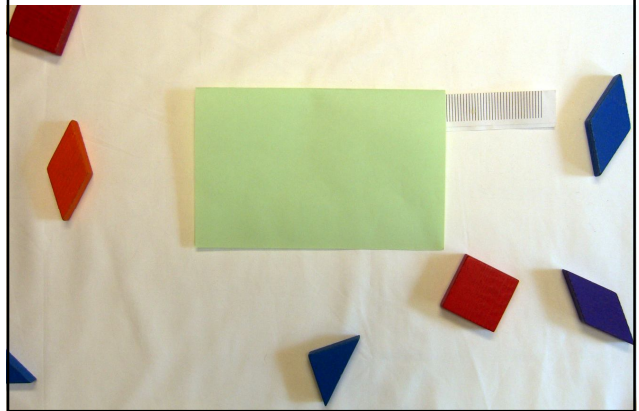

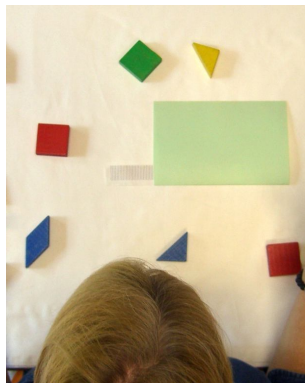
**UN-NUMBERED STRIP IN A FOLDED  
PIECE OF PAPER**



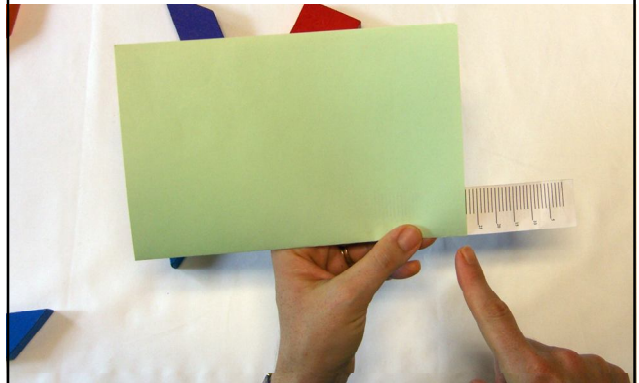
**Spread Brightly Colored Objects Around**



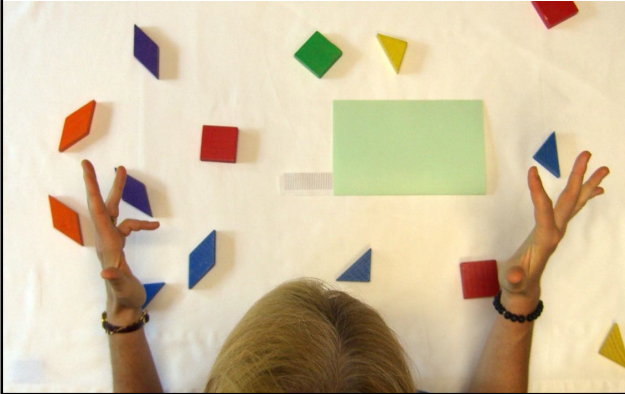
**Patient Counting the Exposed Lines**

### Now Counting With Peripheral Stimulation

- longer lines
- shorter lines
- closer lines
- lines farther apart
- lines in irregular groupings  
with spaces between the groups
- mixed short and long lines
